



Ian Darragh

Born in Larne, County Antrim, Ian Darragh left to study art in London in the early eighties. Now New York based his paintings are often concerned with longing and escape. A lonely horse and rider embark on a mysterious journey, once familiar but now only dimly recounted as in a dream. The magical world of the circus has preoccupied him since earliest childhood. "I ran away but the circus wouldn't have me, he writes. Darragh's pictures share this imagery with artists throughout history. His work was included in an Arts Council touring exhibition which was titled 'The Circus comes to Town' hanging alongside Picasso, Matisse and Roualt.
